



Applicant Checklist

Submit **all** the following items to be considered for admission to Harper College

ALL International Student Applicants

- HARPER COLLEGE APPLICATION — Complete the online application form, www.harpercollege.edu, select the “International Student” option.
- APPLICATION FEE — pay the \$25.00, non-refundable, application fee along with the online application form.
- BANK VERIFICATION — You must attach a bank certification or letter verifying that you and/or your sponsor has at least U.S.\$23,000 available to provide for your first academic year (two semesters) of tuition, fees, and living expenses. You can have more than one sponsor and they can be in the U.S. or a different country.
- HIGHSCHOOL COMPLETION — Submit proof of completion of high school (secondary education). Your diploma or certificate of general education must be translated into English.
- PASSPORT — Submit a copy of the identification page of your passport.
- ENGLISH Proficiency — The requirement is explained on the next column. (See next column for proficiency options)

After completion of your online application form, you will be directed to upload the required documents into the application system electronically.

English Proficiency Requirement

- LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY — Students must submit proof of proficiency for ESL studies **and** for college-level courses.

ESL Applicants

TOEFL iBT Score between 28 and 78
TOEFL Essentials Score between 3.0 and 9.0
IELTS Score between 3.5 and 6.0
DuoLingo Score between 70 and 114
LanguageCert Score between A2 and C1

College Level Applicants

- TOEFL iBT score of 79 or higher
- TOEFL Essentials score of 9.0 or higher
- IELTS score of 6.5 or higher
- DuoLingo Score of 115 or higher
- LanguageCert score of C1 or C2
- Passed English 101 at a U.S. college or university

Applicants with Dependent Spouse and/or Children

- BANK VERIFICATION — Your bank certificate or letter must show proof of additional \$3,000 for each dependent.
- PASSPORT — Submit a copy of each dependent's identification page from the passport

Transfer Students (already in the U.S.)

- Transcript from your current U.S. school
- Printed copy of your Form I-94. You can access the electronic record from www.cbp.gov/i94. Click on the link, “Get I-94 Number Now”.
- Copies of your current Form I-20



To receive college transfer credit from your home country university, you must submit a **course-by-course** equivalency report from
