ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

2014 CONCRETE PAVING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

1.01 BID INFORMATION

- A. Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Trustees, Harper College on, Wednesday, October 15, 2014 at 3:00 p.m. prevailing time for furnishing all necessary labor, equipment, and material for the **2014 Concrete Paving Improvements Project**– Bid Request Q00780 at Harper College at 1200 W. Algonquin Road, Palatine, Illinois 60067.
- B. Work includes (but is not limited to) the following: pavement demolition, pavement saw-cutting, concrete paving, concrete edge grinding, trench drain installation, utility piping installation, joint sealing, excavation, and backfill.
- C. Bid proposals will be received for the above noted project at the scheduled time of receipt of bids and will be publicly opened at that time.
- D. A pre-bid meeting has been scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Monday, October 6, 2014, prevailing time at 1200 W. Algonquin Road, Building-A, Room A343, Palatine, Illinois. All Bidders are encouraged to attend and sign-in at the meeting which will also be attended by the Owner and Architect.
- E. Bid security in the form of a bid bond in an amount equal to 10 percent (10%) of the aggregate of the Base Bid amount and all Alternate Bid amounts shall be submitted with the bid. 100 percent (100%) Performance, Labor and Material Payment Bonds, and Certificate of Insurance will be required from the successful bidder.
- F. Bids shall be submitted in an opaque sealed envelope addressed to: Purchasing Manager, Harper College, 1200 W. Algonquin Road, Building-A, Room A217, Palatine, Illinois 60067.
- G. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety days after the submission without the consent of the Board of Trustees.
- H. Any bid submitted unsealed, unsigned, fax transmission, e-mail, or received subsequent to the aforementioned date and time, may be disqualified and returned to the bidder.
- I. Harper College reserves the right to reject any or all bids or parts thereof, to waive any irregularities or informalities in bidding procedures and to award the contract in a manner best serving the interest of the College.
- J. All bidders must comply with applicable Illinois Law requiring the payment of prevailing wages by all Contractors working on public works. Bidder must comply with the Illinois Statutory requirements regarding labor, including Equal Employment Opportunity Laws.
 1. Contractors shall pay not less than the prevailing rates of wages to all laborers, workmen and mechanics performing work under this contract, and shall comply with the requirements of the Illinois Wages of Employees on Public Works Act (820 ILCS 130/1-12).
