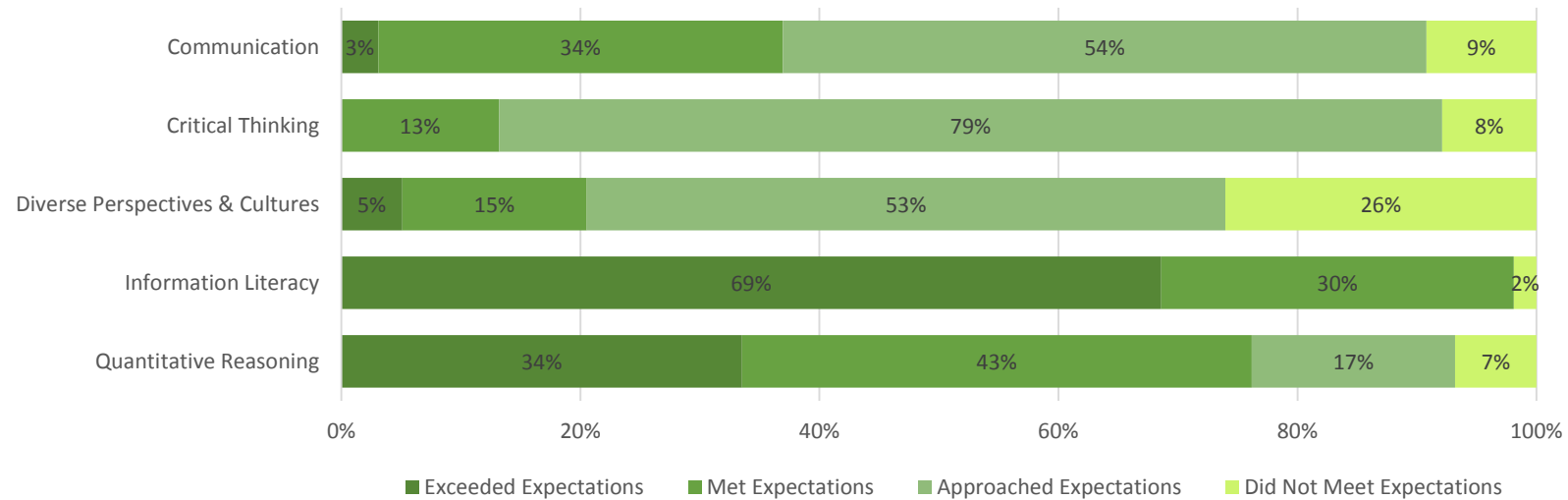

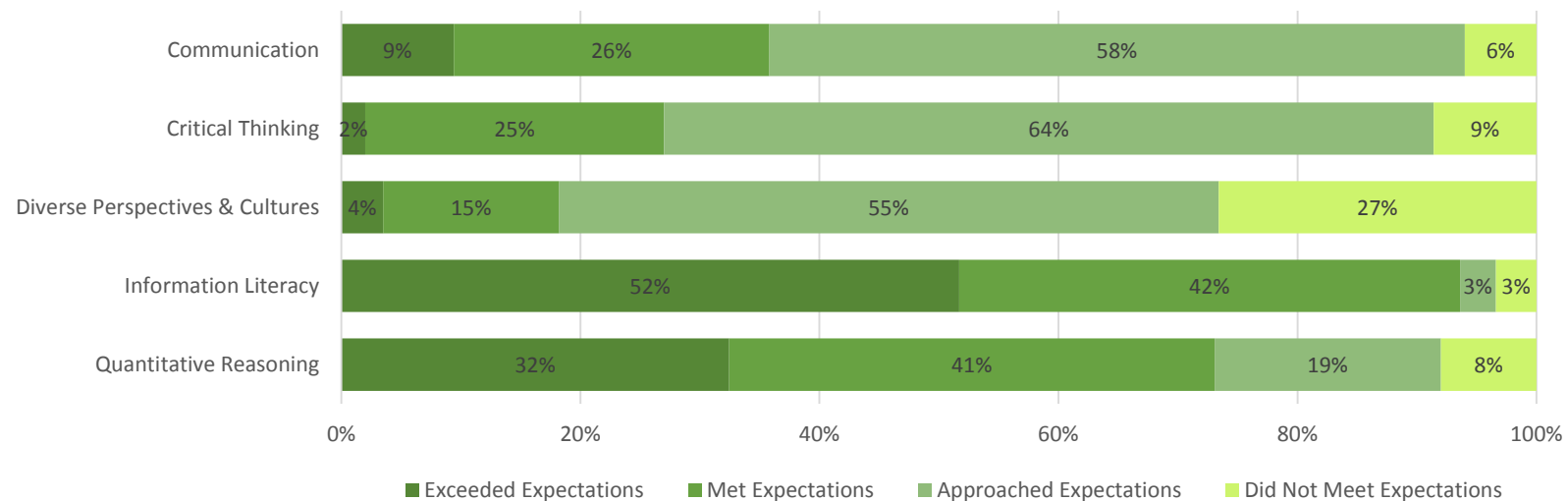
General Education Assessment and Improvement

Harper's General Education Learning Outcomes provide student learning goals that pertain to all associate-degree programs. Harper conducts General Education assessment annually. The Learning Assessment Committee and its Work Groups lead the assessment, and faculty members across the College measure the outcome within their courses. At least one General Education learning outcome is assessed each year. The College focuses on students with 45+ credit hours, as those who are nearing completion of their degree programs.
