In response to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, there will be adjustments to the Harper College Promise Scholarship Program criteria. Please review the following changes:.

COMMUNITY SERVICE: Community Service hour requirements for the current semester will be prorated and added to next semester's requirements. Here are the combined hours and due dates:

Harper Scholar	<u>15 hours total</u> due by the end of Fall 2020 semester (December 2020)
<p>Please note: If you have already met all or part of this semester's community service requirement, those hours will be counted (up to 10 hours) toward the Fall semester requirement.</p> <p>For example: If you already completed 7 hours for the Spring semester, you are only required to complete 8 more hours by the end of Fall 2020.</p>
