Only graduates of Harper's Practical Nursing Certificate (PNC) Program are eligible to apply to the Bridge to Advanced Nursing Program.

Important Dates

Spring 2026 Bridge Application Dates...... June 15, 2025 – September 15, 2025

Program Prerequisites

LPN Unencumbered License

 A copy of your current LPN License must be attached to your application. If you do not have a valid LPN license your application will not be processed.

Harper Grade Point Average

• Students must have a minimum **2.0 grade point average at Harper** at the time of application to the Nursing Program. **If your GPA is below a 2.0, your application will not be processed.**

PN Fundamentals – NUR 101

- Must have been completed with a grade of C or better on the first attempt only for admission points
- No time limit

PN Medical Surgical Nursing - NUR 102

- Must have been completed with a grade of C or better on the first attempt only for admission points
- No time limit

PN Field Experience - NUR 104

- Must have been completed with a grade of C or better on the first attempt only for admission points
- No time limit

PN Advanced Pharmacology - NUR 213

- Must have been completed with a grade of C or better on the first attempt only for admission points
- No time limit

Work Experience (for students who completed NUR104 in 2020)

- For all students who completed NUR104 anytime in 2020, proof of employment as an LPN for 6 months is **required**.
- Submit an Employment Verification Letter (on company letterhead) with the Bridge application.

Nursing Program Success

• Graduation from Harper College Practical Nursing Certificate Program is required. History of any nursing course failure(s) - grades of D, F or W (withdrawal) will be taken into consideration. Students with past NUR course failure(s) may not be admitted due to poor academic performance.

Admission Decisions

PLEASE NOTE: Although satisfaction of admission requirements will result in an admission decision, it does not guarantee acceptance.

Ranking scores will be calculated based on a point system with a maximum of 80 points; **no points will be added to an admission score for coursework completed** <u>after</u> **the program deadline**. You can calculate your ranking score based on the following chart:

| Factor | 0 points | 15 points | 20 points |

| NUR 101 (first attempt) | С | В | Α |
| NUR 102 (first attempt) | C/P | В | Α |
| NUR 104 (first attempt) | С | В | Α |

The minimum admission score will be determined by the pool of applicants applying for this term.

Important Admission Notes

- It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all necessary documentation is on file. Once your program application has been processed, you will be able to monitor your limited enrollment file online. Go to harpercollege.edu and log into your MyHarper Student Portal; limited enrollment information can be found under the My Academic Record section of the My Harper tab.
- All correspondence regarding your limited enrollment application will be emailed to the Harper email address. It is your responsibility to see that your Personal Profile information is current. To update your information, you will need to contact the One Stop Center, Building A, Room A250.
- Applicants not accepted into the program who wish to be considered in the selection process for a future term must reapply.
- It is very important that you make financial aid preparations well in advance of any deadlines so that you know exactly what resources are available to you.
