| Introduction to Visual Art (ART 105) | offered every Spring |

We offer an additional course fulfilling the Humanities Gen-Ed, usually Literature, once per year.

- *Note: Both MCM 200 and ART 105 fulfill the Fine Arts subcategory of the Humanities Gen-Ed*

| Micro Economics (ECO 211) | offered every Fall (beginning Fall 2019) |
| Macro Economics (ECO 212) | offered every Spring |

We offer an additional course fulfilling the Social Sciences Gen-Ed, usually a Psych. course, each year.

- *Note: CHEM 121 and 122 are designed for STEM majors. If you are not a likely STEM major, AST 101 may be a better option for you.*
- *Note: We hope to begin to offer Life Sciences courses for non-science majors, beginning Fall 2019.*
