What are Learning Communities?

Learning Communities are most commonly two or more courses that:

- are taken together and linked by a theme
- are collaboratively taught by faculty from two or more content areas
- enroll the same students in both or all sections

1. Log into MyHarper Student Portal
2. Select **Registration and Records**
3. Choose **Add/Drop a Course**
4. Select the term and click Submit
5. In the boxes below "Add Classes Worksheet", type the five digit Course Reference Numbers (CRNs) for the two Learning Community Courses
6. Click Submit Changes
7. Finalize your registration
