The First-In-Family Scholarship is designed to assist first-generation college students in achieving their educational goals at Argosy University, Schaumburg. This scholarship opportunity is specifically designed for students enrolled in the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration program. This scholarship is equivalent to a tuition reduction of \$185 per credit hour.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

1. First-generation college student (neither parent has earned a bachelor's degree)
2. Completed associate's degree
3. Minimum CGPA 3.0
4. Minimum GPA 3.25 from major field of study
5. Personal Statement
6. Letters of Recommendation

**First-In-Family Scholarship
Memorandum of Understanding**

The following information outlines the eligibility requirements and conditions for the First-In-Family Scholarship at Argosy University, Schaumburg.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Implementation of the award is contingent upon application and acceptance into program and campus.
2. Must be enrolled in the Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration program.
3. Student must begin classes on a primary class start – Summer I/A, Fall I/A, or Spring I/A.
4. Successful completion of nine (9) credit hours per semester (the first semester scholarship will be awarded prior to coursework completion; all subsequent semester awards must meet this requirement). If student drops below the nine credit hour threshold, he/she can regain eligibility in a future semester.
5. Student must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress.
6. Student must authorize the return of non-title IV funds in order to allow any excess scholarship amounts to be sent back to the lender.
7. Student must have the signed Memorandum of Understanding on file.
8. Must not be employees or family members of employees of The Art Institutes system of schools, Brown Mackie College system of schools, Argosy University, South University, or Education Management Corporation or any subsidiary of Education Management Corporation currently participating in the EDMC Tuition Voucher Program.

Additional Conditions:

1. The scholarship recipient is determined by a scholarship committee at Argosy University, Schaumburg.
2. The scholarship cannot be combined with any national scholarship offerings or the Military Tuition Scholarship; however, it can be combined with campus-based scholarship or partnership offerings, if applicable and selected.
3. The scholarship cannot create a stipend at any time.

General Information

- This scholarship is awarded in the form of a tuition credit and is not redeemable for cash.
- Tuition scholarships are non-transferable.
- The tuition scholarship may not be used to finance optional programs sponsored by the school.
- The scholarship has no cash value.
- Scholarship funds will be prorated during the length of the student's program.

By signing this Memorandum of Understanding, I agree that:

1. I have chosen to accept the First-In-Family Scholarship.
2. If I fail to meet any of the eligibility requirements, the scholarship will be suspended the following semester.
