

**Transfer Guide--From William Rainey Harper to Concordia University Chicago
For Business Majors**

To earn a CUC business degree, students must complete the General Education Core:

- Communications (9 hours)
- Humanities (9 hours)
- Logical & Mathematical Reasoning (B.A.--3 hours; B.S.--6 hours)
- Natural Sciences (7-8 hours including one laboratory course)
- Social & Behavioral Sciences (9 hours)
- Freedom & Responsibility (3 hours)
- Values & Virtues (3 hours)
- Theology (6-12 hours)
- Fitness & Wellness (2 hours)
- Foreign Language (0-6 hours)--Waived for students with two or more years of high school credit in ONE language
