

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
HARPER COLLEGE  
AND  
DEPAUL UNIVERSITY**

**BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN ELEMENTARY EDUCATION**

This Articulation Agreement is entered into by **HARPER COLLEGE** and **DEPAUL UNIVERSITY** for the purpose of assisting students to pursue the Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education at **DEPAUL UNIVERSITY** by recognizing and giving credit for specific core courses completed successfully (a grade of C and above) at **HARPER COLLEGE**.

**DEPAUL UNIVERSITY** is a private university that is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, and **HARPER COLLEGE** is a public, two year institution that is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

Whereas, it is the shared goal of both institutions to promote educational opportunities available to the students of **HARPER COLLEGE** by providing a cooperative basis for these students to make progress toward the achievement of the Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education at **DEPAUL UNIVERSITY**.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that both institutions agree to the following:

**HARPER COLLEGE** agrees to assist and advise all students who desire to continue their studies toward the achievement of the Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education at **DEPAUL UNIVERSITY**.

**DEPAUL UNIVERSITY** agrees to accept students' academic credits associated with successfully completed coursework generated by **HARPER COLLEGE** in accordance with the attached guide to specific foundations courses that will assist students in making progress toward achieving a Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education at DePaul University.

Students must meet the Teacher Education admission requirements specified by **DEPAUL UNIVERSITY**.

**HARPER COLLEGE** and **DEPAUL UNIVERSITY** mutually agree to periodically review the attached degree course guide and to consider future modifications to its content. This agreement is renewable and has an initial term of three years from the date all authorizing signatures from the cited institutions are affixed to this document.
