Transfer Guide

Students wishing to transfer from Harper College into the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Communication Design program at Harrington College of Design should take the following course of study at Harper to ensure that credit transfer is maximized.

Transfer students are not required to complete a set number of transfer credits before being accepted into the bachelor's program. Transfer students are accepted to begin classes at Harrington throughout the academic year. Students should meet with a Harrington representative to decide on the best time to start classes.

Please note, students may transfer up to 50% of any degree program. This transfer guide covers 59 credits.
