

**Memorandum of Degree Completion/Transfer Agreement
Between
Harper College (HARPER) and International Academy of Design and Technology-
Chicago/Schaumburg (IADT)**

Harper College and the International Academy of Design and Technology form a cooperative relationship through this articulation agreement to better serve our constituents, to provide a seamless transfer process, to minimize duplication of instruction, and to build on associate degree and baccalaureate degree learning experiences. Both institutions recognize that working together, their collective efforts are stronger than their individual efforts.

After completion of the Associate of Applied Science in Interior Design from Harper College, students are eligible for the transfer of credits toward the completion of a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Interior Design at the International Academy of Design and Technology. Students with an A.A.S. in Interior Design from Harper will receive full transfer credit according to the curriculum outline(s) indicated below:
