

Articulation Agreement

Effective today, The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg and William Rainey Harper College agree to enter into an articulation agreement to benefit those Harper College students who have successfully completed an Associate of Applied Science in Interior Design and wish to pursue a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Interior Design. Students must complete the agreement as outlined below.

The awarding of credits shall be based upon a completed application from the student and a review/evaluation of the following:

1. Student must have completed the degree within five years prior to matriculation at The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg.
2. Student must earn a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average of "C" or better for the Associate of Applied Science to transfer into The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg.
3. Student must be fully accepted into The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg as a baccalaureate seeking student in Interior Design.
4. Official transcripts from William Rainey Harper College must be submitted to the Transcript Evaluator at The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg prior to matriculation.
5. The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg will accept a maximum of 88 quarter credits as transfer.

This agreement is specifically designed for students who wish to attend The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg. This agreement allows the student to transfer in 68 credits within the Interior Design program (specified on Table A) and 20 general education credits, a total of 88 quarter credits. In order to fulfill the requirements of this agreement, the student is responsible for successfully completing the following courses at William Rainey Harper College.



Each party also agrees to notify the other of any changes in their respective program curriculum that would necessitate a re-evaluation of the articulation agreement.
