THIS ARTICULATION AGREEMENT is specifically designed for students who have completed their AA degrees in majors other than hospitality management and are interested in completing their BA degrees at Kendall's Les Roche School of Hospitality Management. They can earn their bachelor's degrees in as little as two years or take the time required to fit school into their work schedule.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS – All students must complete minimum residency requirements of 48 quarter hours. In addition, the final 12 credits of coursework must be completed at Kendall.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS – Students must submit applications for admission and official transcripts from all colleges attended to the Kendall College Office of Admissions. A minimum GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (C average) is required for admission.

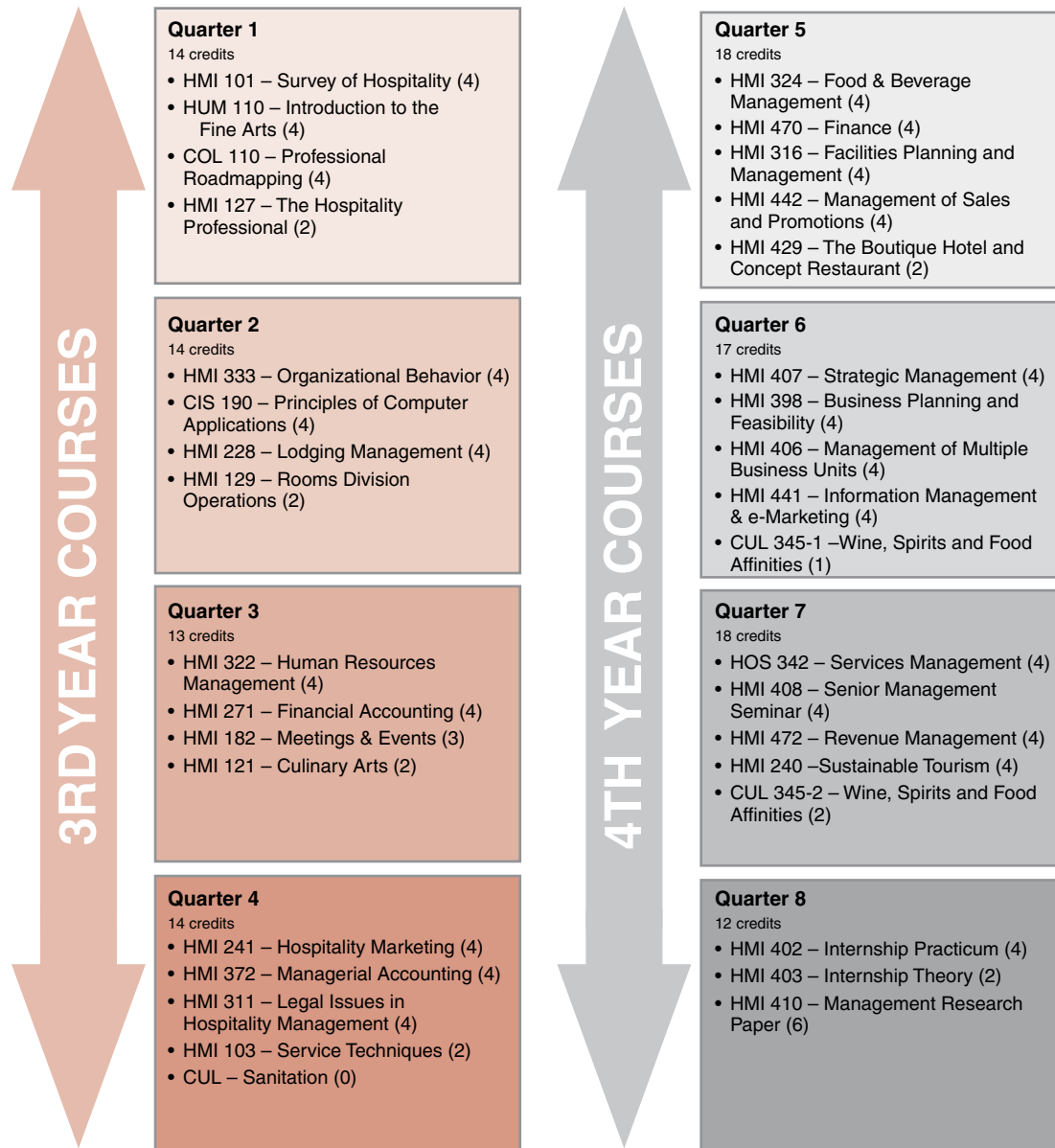

TYPICAL 2-YEAR PROGRAM SEQUENCE

This sequence is designed for students who wish to complete their Bachelor's Degree as quickly as possible. Kendall advisors will work with students who wish to take a lighter class load to sequence their courses over a longer period of time.



There is an on-campus commitment of two Saturdays per month.

Kendall works to meet individual needs.

- Considerations are made if students have had courses equivalent to those listed above.
- Credits are in quarter hours.
- Total credits toward BA must total a minimum of 120 semester hours or 180 quarter hours.
