TRANSFER OPTIONS

- **Completed AA or AS degree:** will be evaluated by NLU as completing the lower division general education requirements; however, there may be additional courses required in your major.
- **IAI GECC:** Completing *only* the IAI General Education Core at Harper (no AA/AS) will be evaluated by NLU as completing the lower division general education requirements; however, there may be additional courses required in your major.
- **Completing some courses at Harper:** If transferring prior to completing the IAI General Education Core at Harper, students will be required to follow NLU's general education requirements to complete the baccalaureate degree.

TRANSFER CREDITS

The maximum number of semester hours transferable from a community college is 93. Additional credit for military service is possible, depending on the program.

NLU will accept "D" grades from Harper students if they have received their AA or AS degrees from Harper.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 2.0 – 2.5 GPA depending on the program.

CALCULATION OF ADMISSION GPA

Developmental courses will not be used in calculating an admission GPA. Only the last repeated grade will be used in calculation for admission.

- NLU has terms instead of semesters and uses Quarter Hours instead of Semester Hours
 - (Fall term – Sept. to Nov., Winter term – Jan. to March, Spring term – April to June, Summer Term- June to Aug.)
 - (1 Semester Hour = 1.5 Quarter hours, 60 SH = 90 QH, 120 SH = 180 QH)
