Sample 3+1 Curriculum Guide for students with an Associate in Applied Science Degree-International Business

Northwood University in cooperation with Harper College has designed a program that permits Harper College students to complete the third year of a Bachelor of Business Administration Degree Program through specific courses that are comparable to courses required in the Northwood program.
