

TRANSFER AGREEMENT

**Between
Purdue University Calumet
and
Harper College**

For Transfer of Harper College's Associate of Applied Science in Nursing Degree to Purdue University Calumet, Professional Nursing Pathways Online Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree Program

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this transfer agreement is to provide a basis for a cooperative relationship between Purdue University Calumet (PUC) and Harper College (HC) to benefit students who desire to complete a bachelor's degree. The intent is for HC students completing the Associate of Applied Science degree plan to move seamlessly to the Bachelor of Science degree plan.

Transfer Agreement

Graduates from 2013 onward of Harper College with an Associate of Applied Science in Nursing may transfer and apply at least 60 credits from that completed degree to requirements for Purdue University Calumet, Professional Nursing Pathways Online Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree Program.

Addendum One: Course Requirements for Transfer

Additionally, under the terms of this agreement:

Harper College agrees to the following:

1. Identify an individual to serve as the Professional Pathways Program Coordinator for HC.
2. Assist students to submit official transcripts to Purdue University Calumet admissions team within 30 days after the applicant has completed his or her third semester. Assist students to submit official transcripts with final grade information, degree conferred and conferral date for *Purdue University Calumet Professional Nursing Pathways Program* applicants within 30 days following the posting of the final AASN grades.
3. Notify Purdue University Calumet if there are any changes in the Harper College degree plan that impacts the students' qualifications to enter Purdue University Calumet.
4. The Professional Nursing Pathways Program Coordinator will work with a Purdue University Calumet representative to ensure Harper College students and alumni access to the program. Activities include but are not limited to the following:

- a. Announce the Partnership to students and post information on the program on the HC transfer information web pages,
 - b. Assist PUC in supporting students enrolled in the Professional Nursing Pathways Program who have given HC consent to provide information to PUCSON.
5. The head of HC AASN nursing program will:
- a. Assist with communicating information on the Pathways Program to AASN alumni.
 - b. Post *Purdue University Calumet Professional Nursing Pathways Program* posters in the nursing department.

Purdue University Calumet agrees to the following:


1. Provide the Purdue University Calumet RN to BSN degree program with multiple start dates per year.
2. Provide Harper College with a degree plan including all recommended general education courses that should be completed in addition to the AASN nursing curriculum in order to enter into Purdue University Calumet's online RN to BSN program.
3. Notify Harper College if there are any changes in the degree plan or admissions criteria that impact students' qualifications to enter Purdue University Calumet.
4. Provide graphics, templates, posters and other materials in order to assist Harper College with informing nursing and alumni of this program.
5. Provide a detailed, step-by-step student instruction sheet
6. The initial term of the agreement shall be until December 1, 2013, and will automatically renew in one-year increments thereafter. If either party desires to cancel the agreement, they may do so at any time via 90 day written notification to the partner party below signed.
7. In the event that Harper College terminates the Partnership, Harper College agrees to assist students to send all transcripts as enumerated in Section 3 above for those who applied to the *Purdue University Calumet Professional Nursing Pathways Program* prior to termination.
8. Harper College students are eligible for admission with junior standing to Purdue University Calumet provided:
 - a. The student completes an online application for admission to Purdue University Calumet and submits a transcript review fee.
 - b. A course grade of "C" or better must be earned to be accepted for transfer.


- c. The student has a 2.5 or higher cumulative grade point average on a 4 point scale.
9. As HC graduates complete the 120 credit hour requirement for the award of the Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing, they must meet the graduation requirements as approved by Purdue University Calumet at the time of the student's admission to the Purdue University Calumet Bachelor of Science, major in Nursing program.
 10. Written notice of intention to terminate, modify, or withdraw from this Articulation Agreement will be submitted by the academic head of either institution at least one academic semester prior to the proposed date of termination/withdrawal. Should a decision be made to modify or dissolve this agreement, students who are already attending Purdue University Calumet at the time will be permitted to continue as long as their academic performance remains in good standing.
 11. Recognizing that changes in curricula and course content are inevitable, each institution agrees to discuss with the other institution all curriculum changes affecting this agreement before the changes are implemented.
 12. A review of this agreement and the resulting programs will take place every three years by the representatives from both institutions.






