Transfer Policy to Saint Joseph's College from Harper College

General Policy:

1. Up to 60 semester hours will be allowed to transfer into Saint Joseph's College.
2. Up to 70 semester hours will be allowed to transfer into Saint Joseph's College with an Associate Degree.
3. The Registrar evaluates all academic work earned at the other institutions.
4. An official and complete transcript of all credit attempted and earned must be received by Saint Joseph's College before an official evaluation can be completed.
5. Advanced Placement (AP) and CLEP will be allowed to transfer into Saint Joseph's College.
6. Credits earned more than 15 years before application are accepted on a provisional basis, subject to validation after thirty semester hours have been completed at Saint Joseph's College with a 2.00 (C) average.
7. Courses with grade of C- or better will transfer as credit hours only; grades do not transfer.
8. The following courses WILL NOT TRANSFER from Harper College.
