At a Glance:

- Location:** In 1859, Valparaiso Male and Female College.
- Admission:** Selective, private, Lutheran, coeducational.
- Facilities:** 60 residential and academic buildings on 310 acres. One hour from Chicago and minutes from the Indiana Dunes National Lakeshore on Lake Michigan.
- Study:** School of Law and six master's degrees.
- Enrollment:** 3,500 students from most states and over 40 countries.
- Faculty:** Over 200 full-time and part-time professors with 89 percent holding terminal or doctorate degrees. The faculty to student ratio: 1:14.
- Programs:** Domestic programs in Chicago, Washington D.C., and New York. International programs in China, England, France, Germany, Greece, Japan, Mexico, and Namibia.
- Technology:** VAX4000 with 300 personal computers for student use, with computer clusters in each residence hall.
- Activities:** Over 150 groups and activities for VU students.
- Sports:** 16 NCAA Division I varsity sports, intramurals for everyone.
- Placement:** VU's job and graduate school placement rate (within a few months of graduation) hovers around 93%.
- Financial Aid:** More than 80% of students receive financial aid; over \$25 million awarded annually.
