LAG 8002 Veterinary Assistant (9-6) 12 crs.

Prepares students for entry level employment in a variety of veterinary settings in private practice, animal shelters, animal control facilities, pet stores, kennels, and veterinary drug companies. Studies how to assist veterinarians and technicians with medical care and treatment for injured animals. Gains practical skills during hands-on labs and observation while participating and completing assigned clinicals. Includes 150 hours of classroom instruction and 100 hours of mandatory clinical. This course is NAVTA approved. Students who successfully complete this program may sit for the AVA exam.
