



DUAL CREDIT: High School Partnership Application Instructions with Screen Shots

To receive college credit for a Dual Credit or Credit by Exam course, you will need to complete the online Harper College High School Partnership Application (the Dual Credit/Credit by Exam application). Please be sure to only use this application, as it is free to high school students. If you use any other form or application, you will be charged a fee. To complete the application, please follow the instructions below.

1. Navigate to www.harpercollege.edu , scroll down and click on the “Apply” box on the main page screen.




2. Click on the underlined link to “Create a New User Account” (located below the Login button).



- Next you will be prompted to **Create an Account**. You will need to enter your **Legal First and Last Name**, along with a **personal** email address.







You will be taken to this screen to reset your password:





- Once you have clicked "SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION" you will be taken to the electronic signature page to sign and verify your application. Complete those items and click "VERIFY AND SUBMIT." You will receive an email confirming your application submission.
