- ☐ Provide a printed copy of your Form I-94. You can access the electronic record from www.cbp.gov/i94. Click on the link: Get I-94 Number Now.
- ☐ Provide copies of your current Form I-20.

- ☐ Bank Verification: Your bank certificate or letter must show proof of additional \$3,000 (U.S. dollars) for each dependent.
- ☐ Passport: Submit a copy of each dependent's identification page from their passport.
