What is the Follow-Up Survey?

The Follow-Up Survey is administrated annually to Harper students who received a Harper **transfer or career credential** within a fiscal year (i.e., summer through spring semesters). Survey responses are used to determine the extent to which the students found **employment**, assess their **satisfaction** with their **Harper experience**, and to gauge the extent to which Harper impacted their **education**. Survey responses provided in this interactive report are from the last seven years of the Follow-Up Survey: **currently Fiscal Years 2017 - 2024 (Use Survey Year filter to view 2017 - 2021)**.

Sections of the Follow-Up Survey Interactive Report

- **Demographics:** Showing the main demographic breakouts of the respondents, separated by survey fiscal year and broken out by credential obtained, gender, and race/ethnic group.
- **Harper Experience:** Question responses around satisfaction with various areas of their Harper experience, e.g., program of study, course instruction, and student services.
- **Employment:** Question responses around employment, especially with relation to Harper's impact on job preparation.
- **Post-Credential Education:** Question responses around education experience after leaving Harper, especially with relation to the preparation at Harper for transferring to another institution.

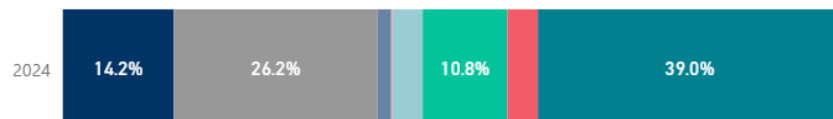

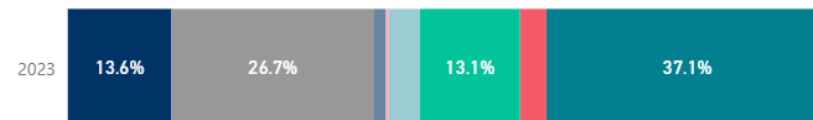
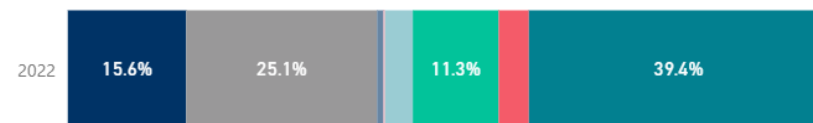
Respondent Demographics by Survey Year

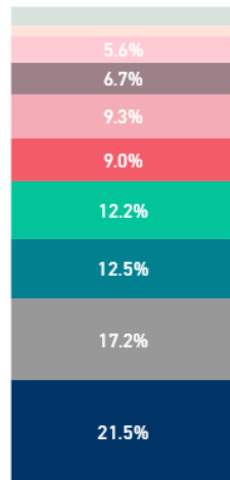

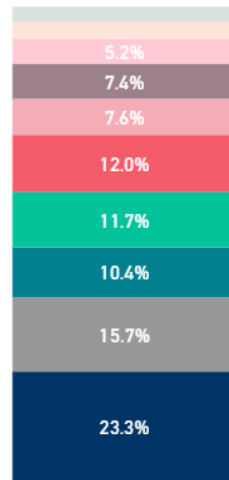

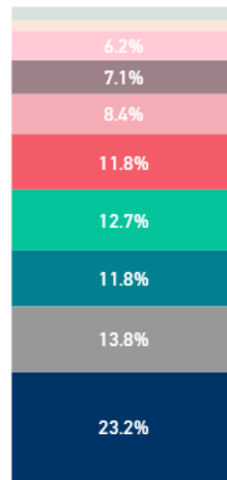

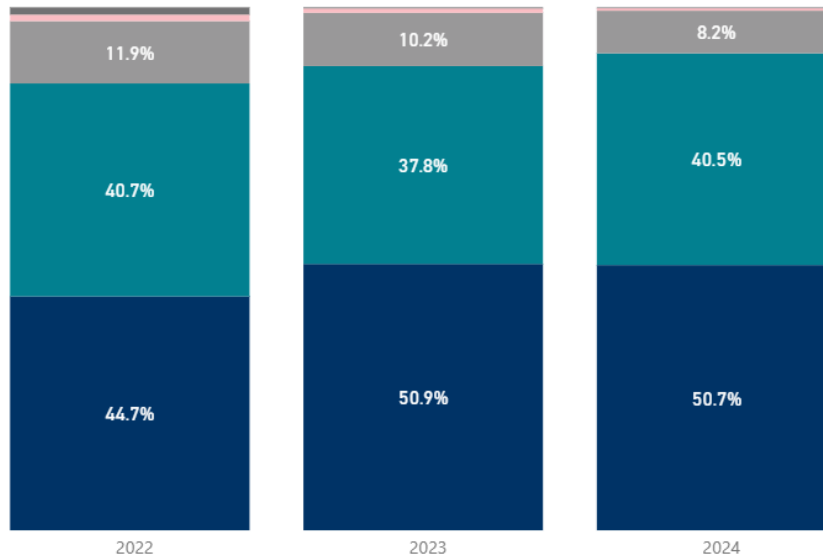
