

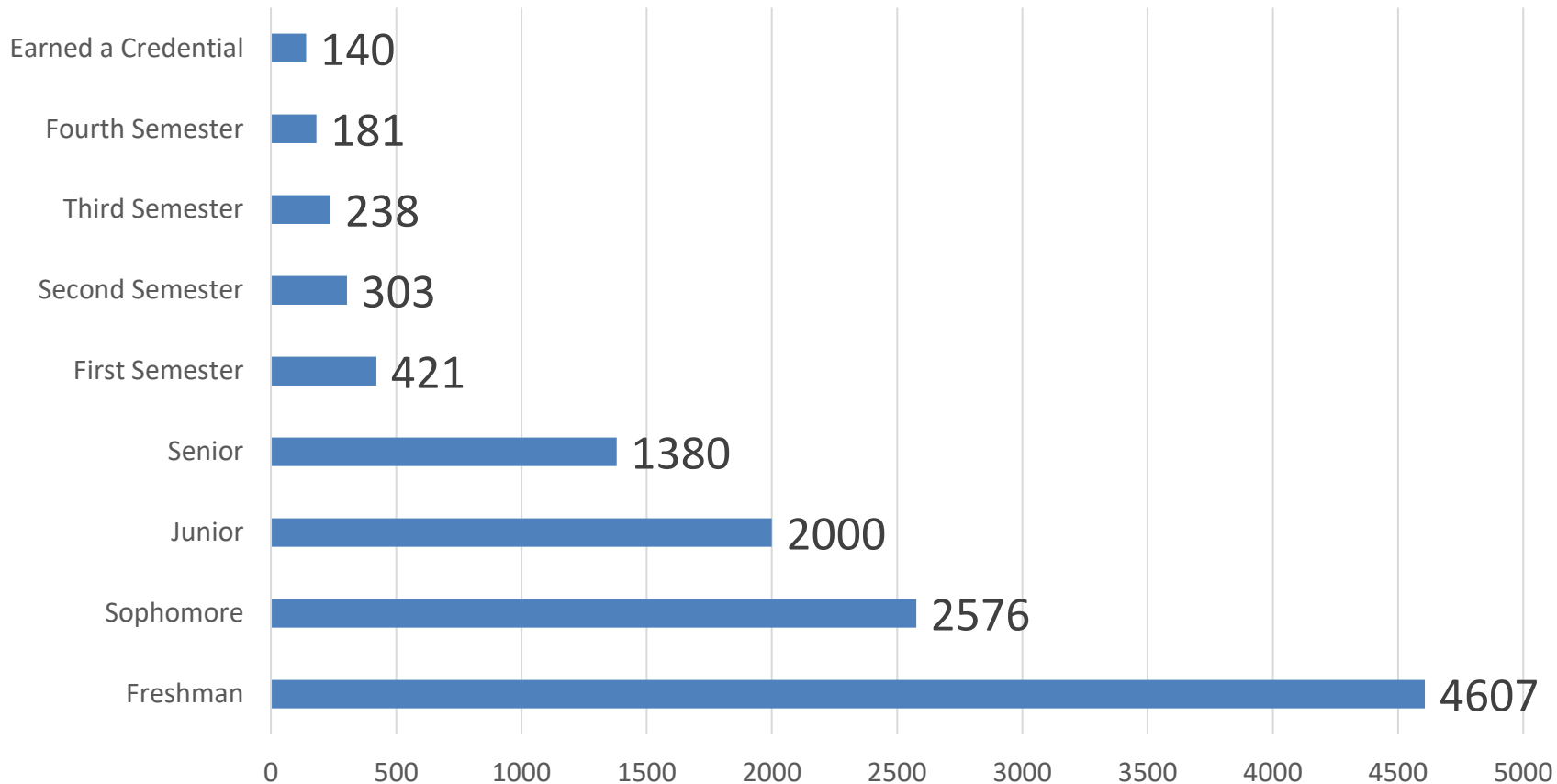

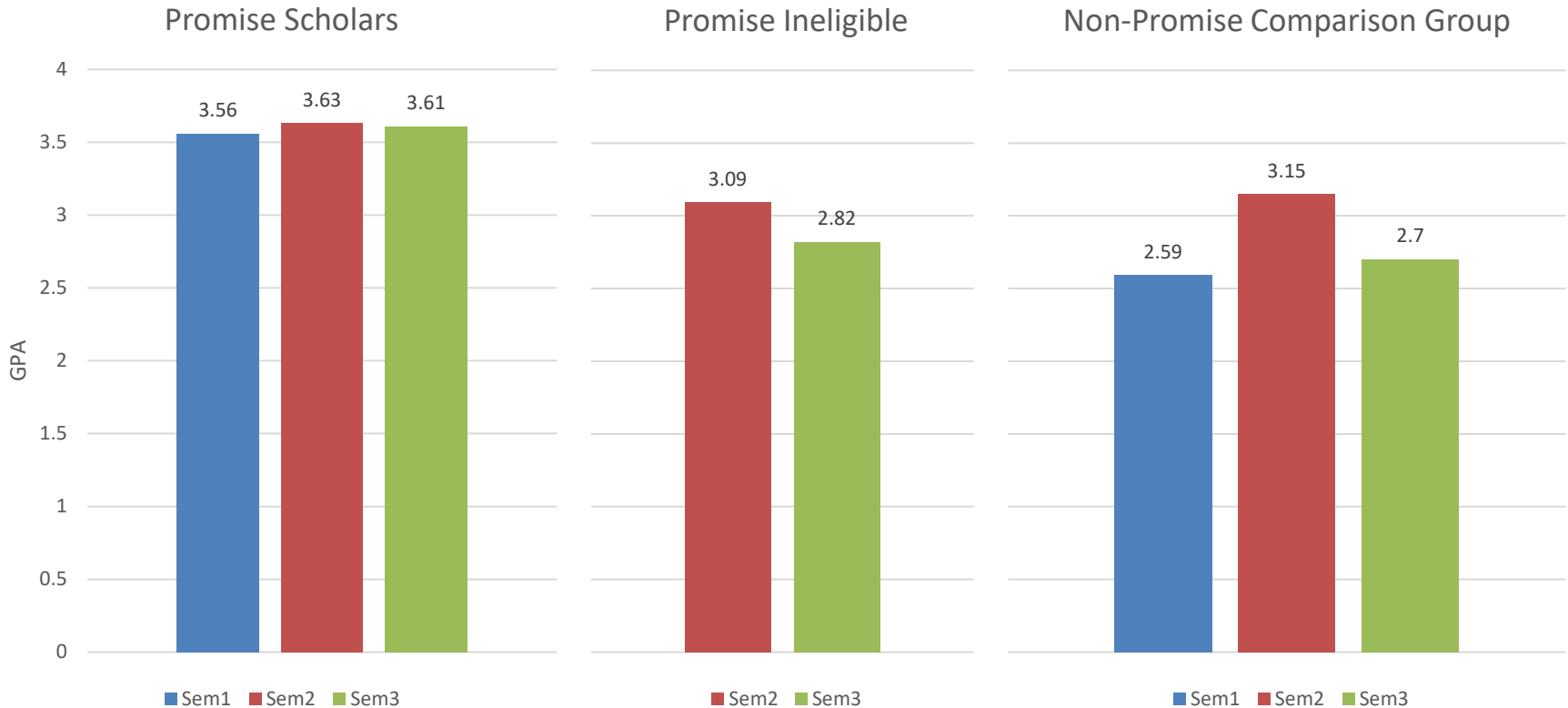

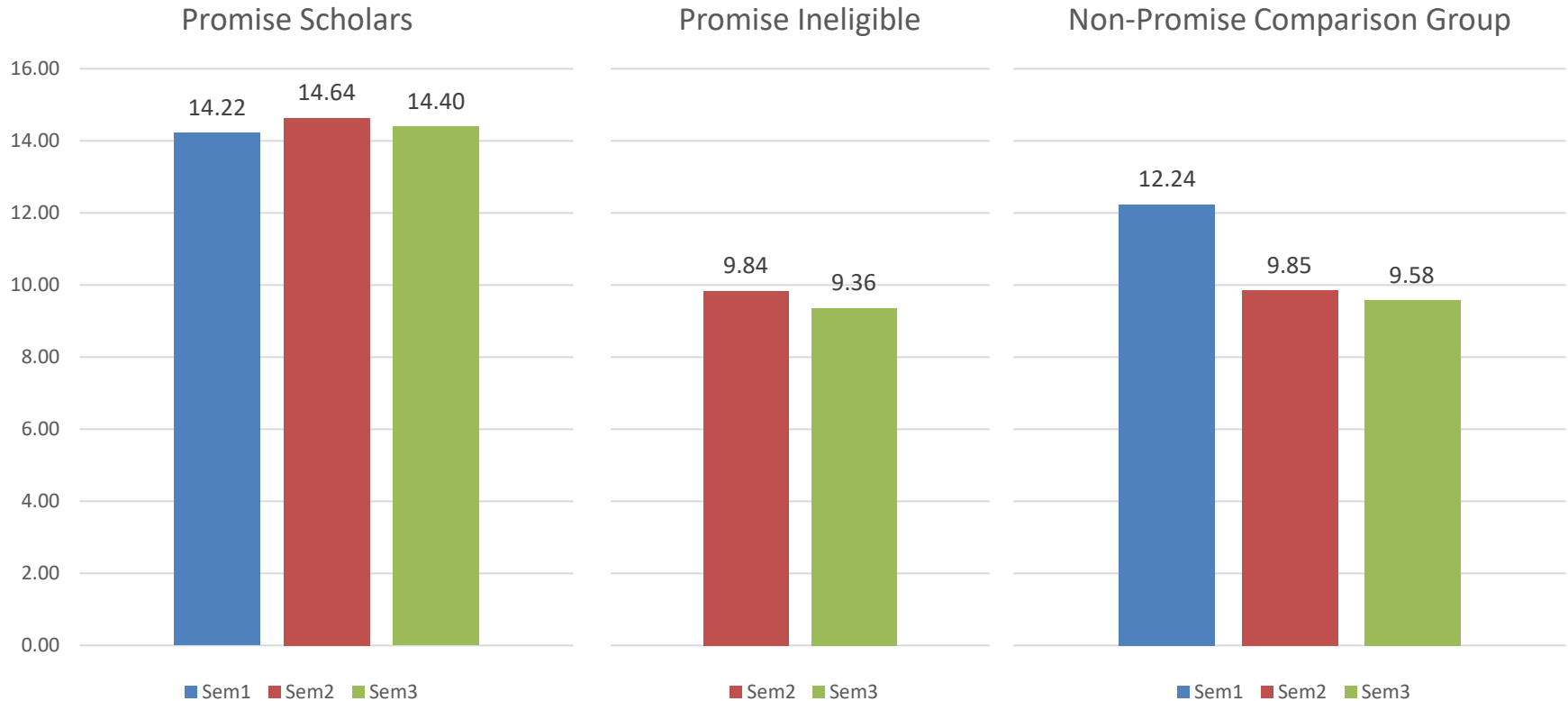

Promise Comparison – Average Term GPA



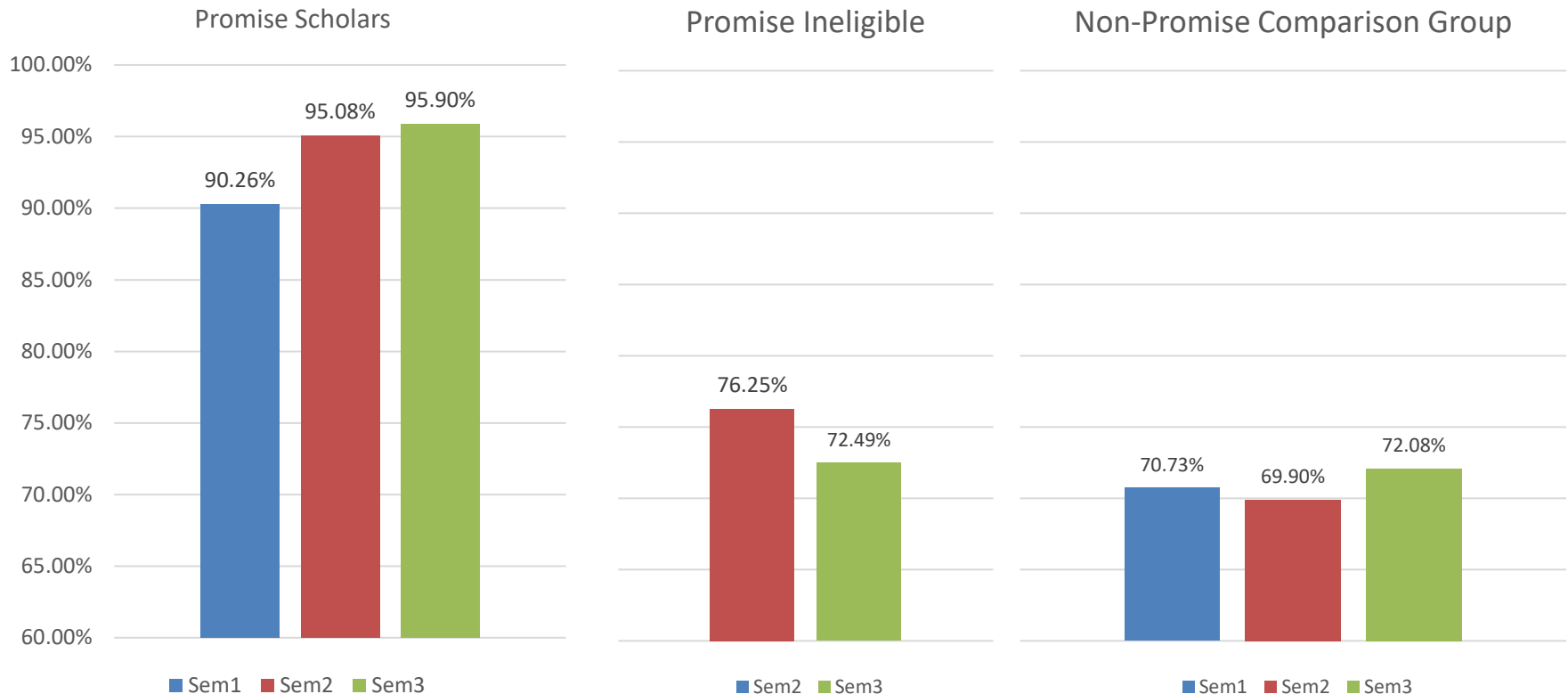
Promise Comparison – Average Credits Earned

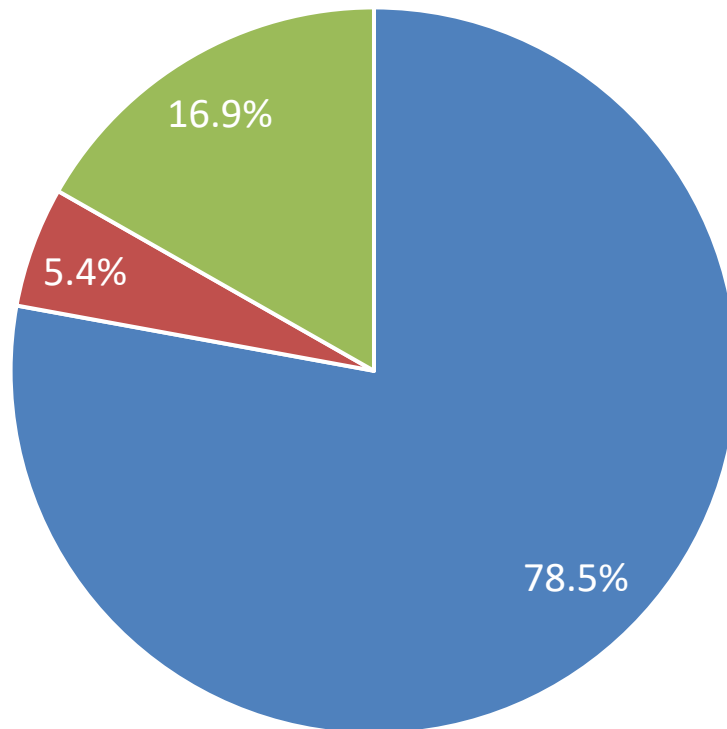
