

On the Horizon for 2021-2022...

- Launch the Cultural Center
- Implement DEI training program for all employees
- Engage senior leadership in professional development
- Revive 360° evaluation with the addition of DEI questions

- Establish a cycle of data review related to DEI
- Assess policies/practices for equity adjustments
- Develop procedures and protocols to ensure use of common inclusive language in College materials
- Create an awards program to recognize excellence and DEI
