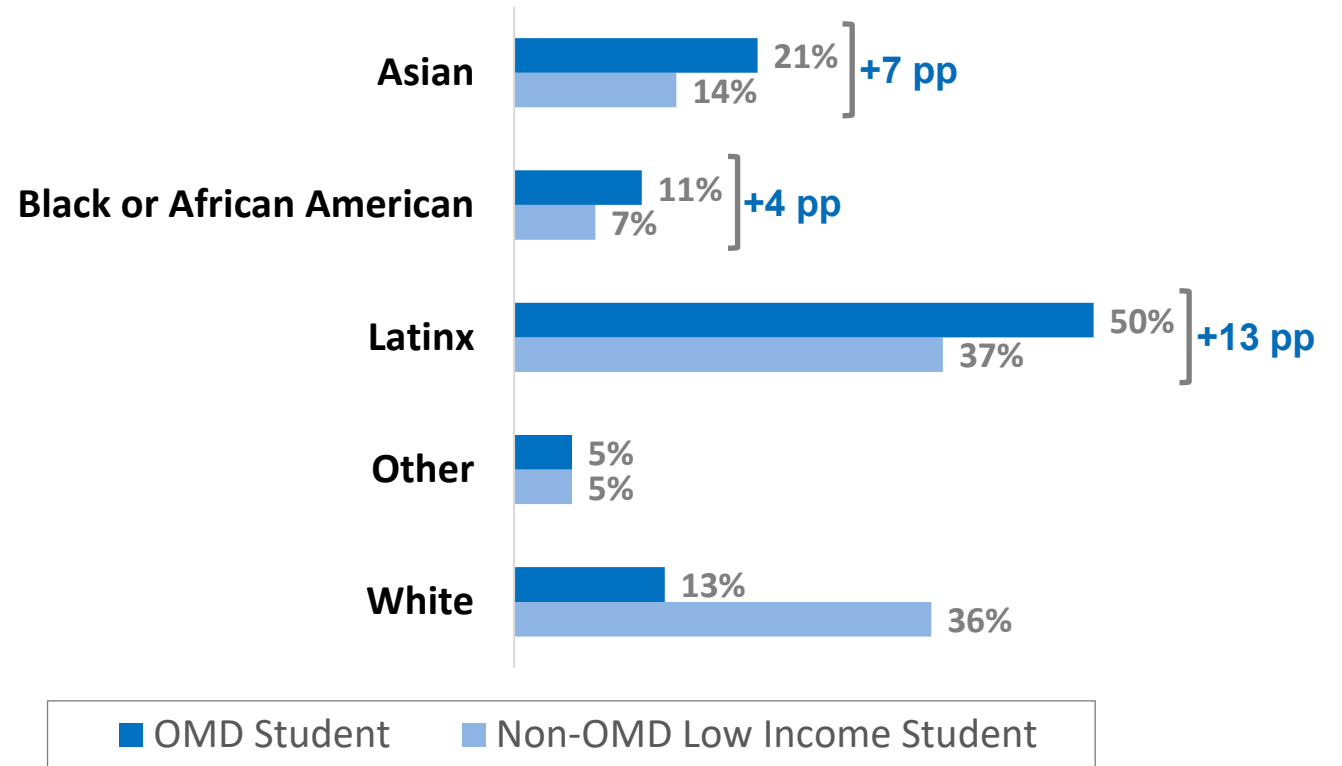

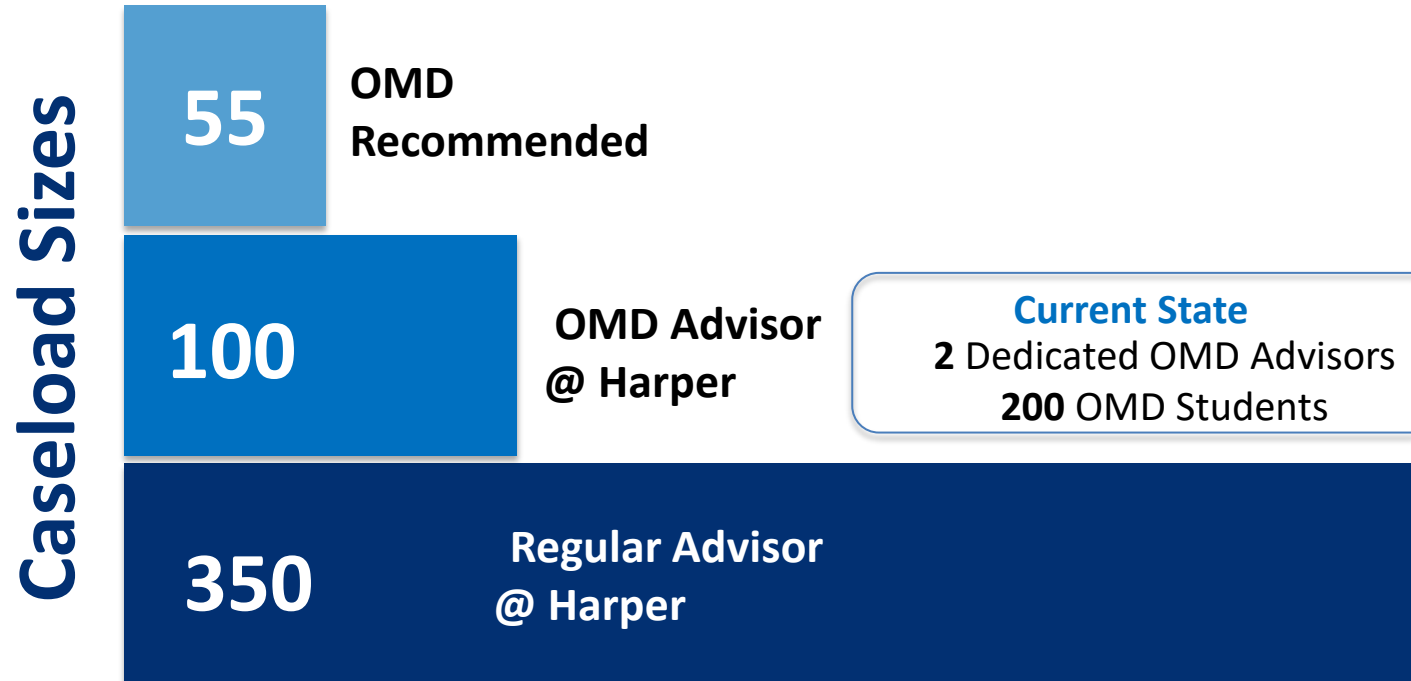


From **tutoring** and **coaches** to **financial assistance** and **professional development**, OMD offers the support to attract **low-income students** and/or **undocumented students** to Harper.

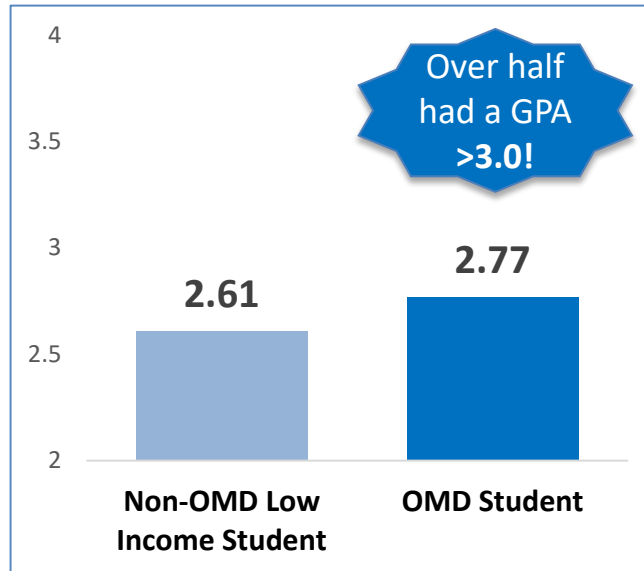


The OMD holistic, wraparound support model

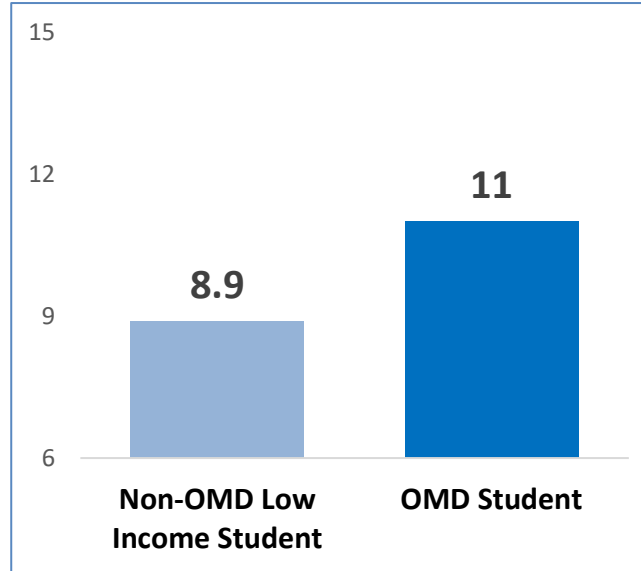

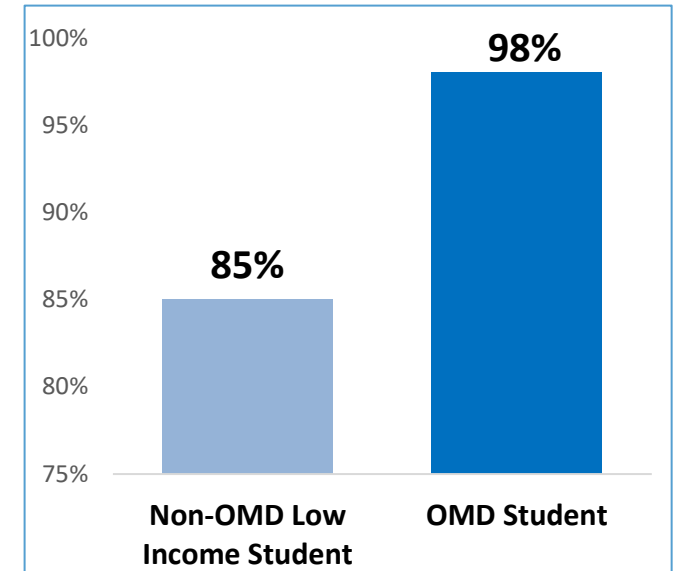

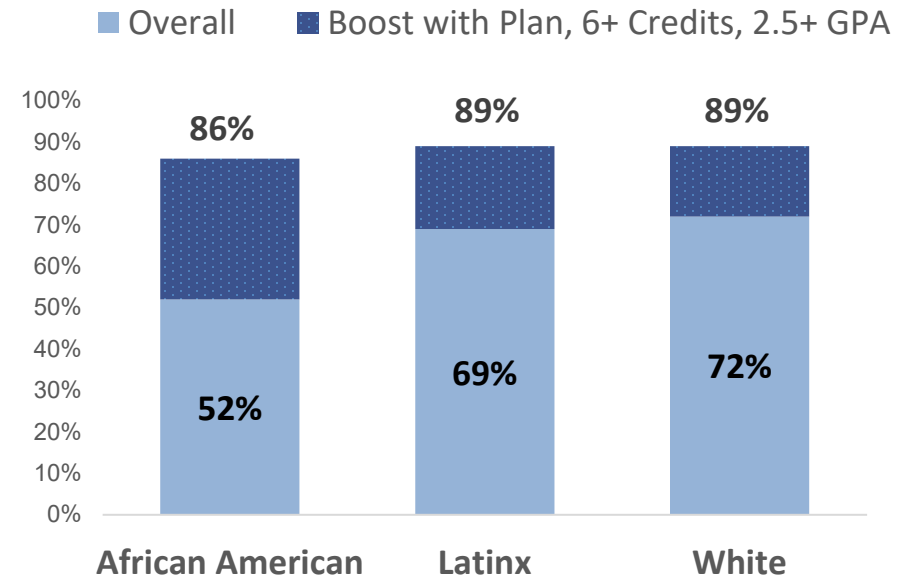
Momentum Points That Reduce Equity Gaps

Fall to Fall Persistence: *The Biggest Predictor of Completion*

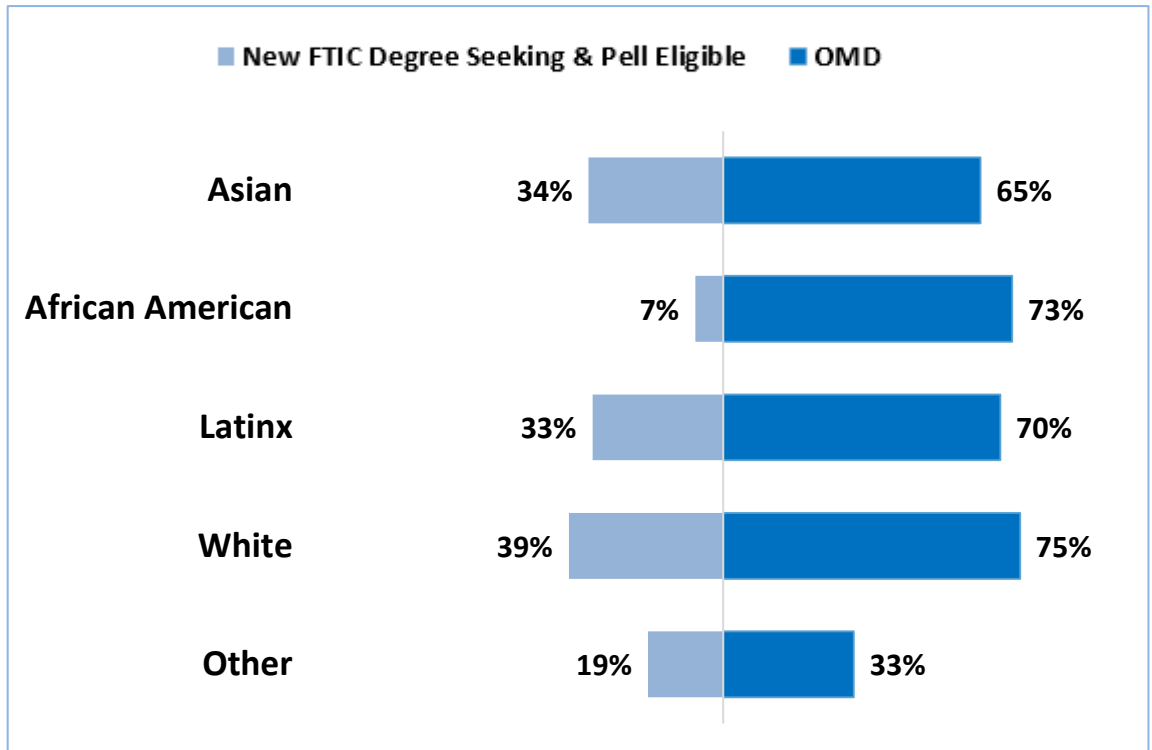
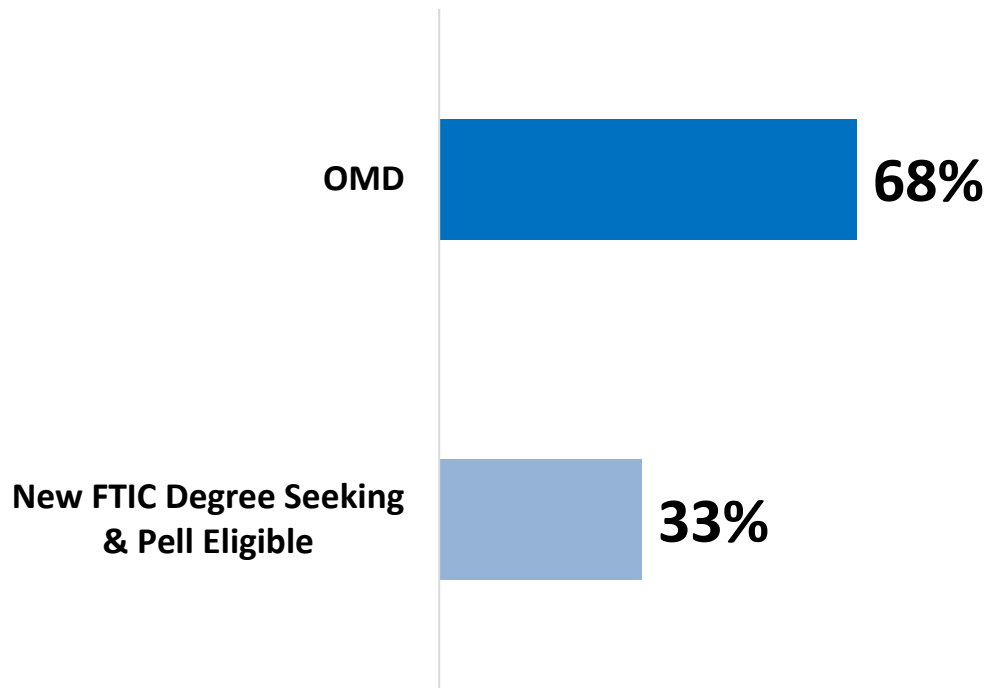
(Degree Seeking Students: Fall 2017-Fall 2019)

Fall 2017 Cohort Graduation Rates

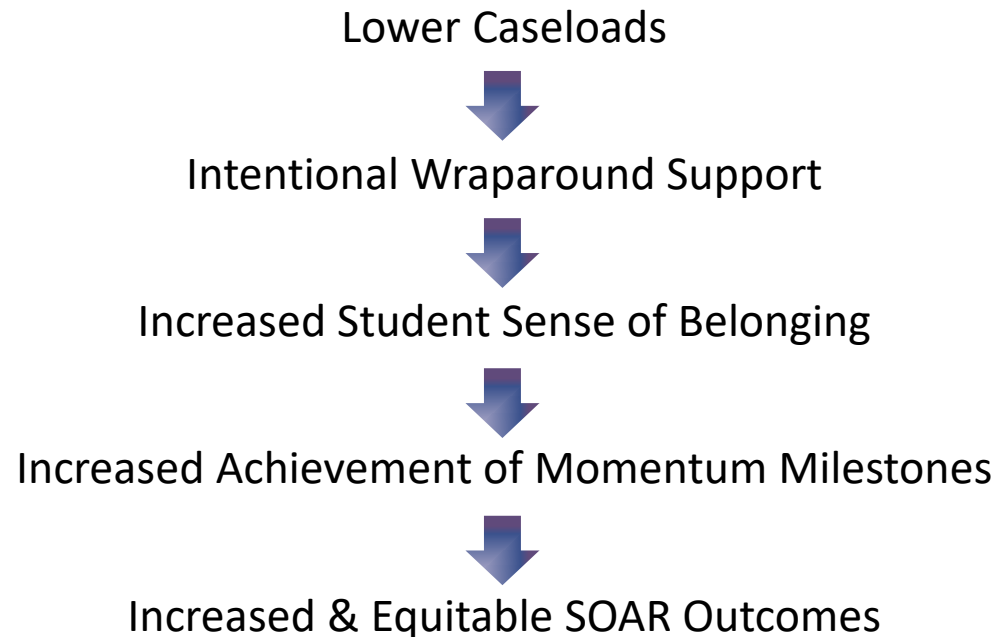
