- 20+ programs (degree and certificate) can be completed fully online
- Programs that used development model (Health Information Technology, ESL Endorsement, Bilingual Education Endorsement)

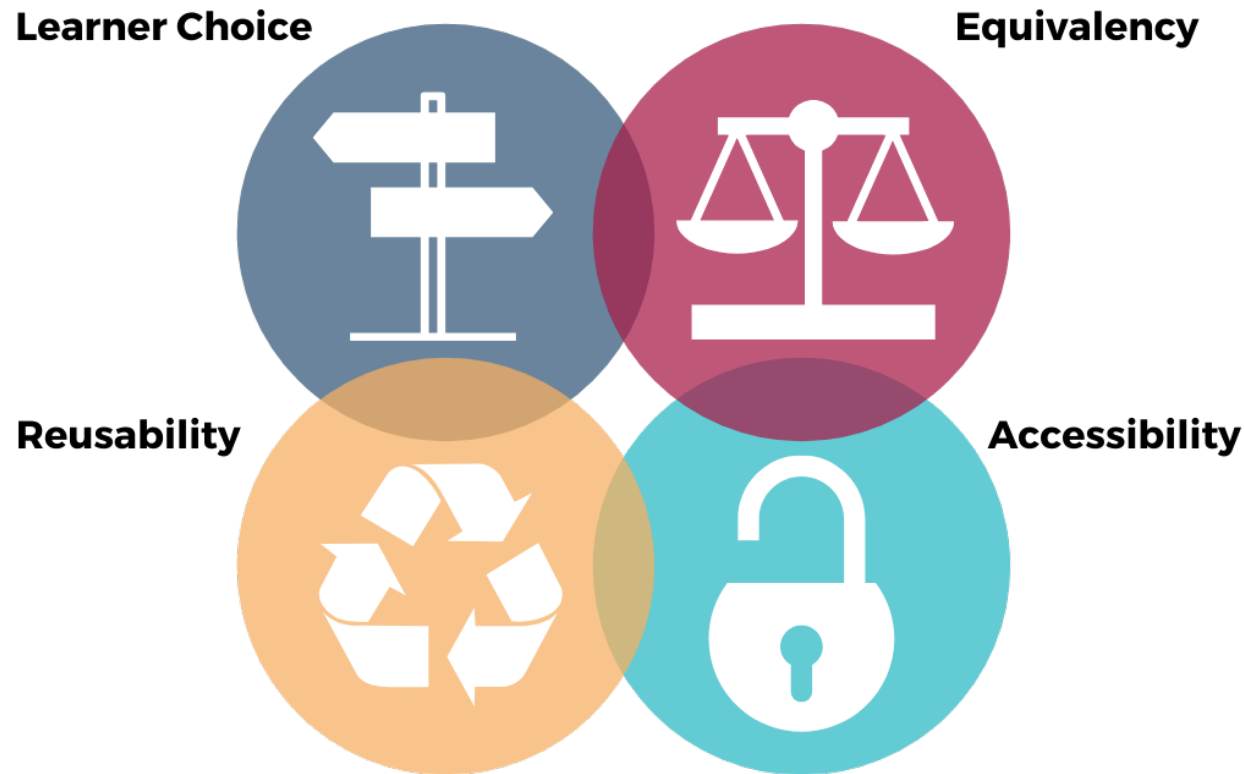

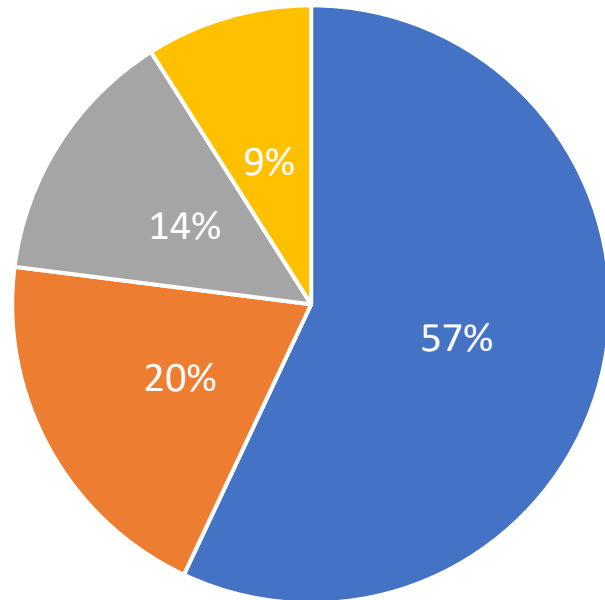
