

Policy Updates

- Conducted institutional policy review.
- Identified revisions for the Acceptable Use Policy to incorporate generative AI standards.
- Updates focus on appropriate, ethical use of generative AI by employees and students.
- These updates are currently under review by the Shared Governance Committees.



Tool Recommendation

- Recommended Microsoft Copilot as the primary AI tool supported across the institution.
- Basic tier Copilot already accessible to employees through their Harper logins.
- Offers data security and privacy for prompts and outputs.
- Currently evaluating other generative AI tools for employee usage.



Approval Process

- Developing an approval process for generative AI tool requests.
- Ensuring that approved tools are secure and promote data privacy and security.
- Proposed process will be presented to the Executive Cabinet for review and consideration.
- Finalized process and tool recommendations will be communicated to the college



Next steps

June 2025

- Board of Trustees (BOT) to review updates to the Acceptable Use Policy (first reading).
- Taskforce to release an approved list of generative AI tools.
- Taskforce to publish the approval process for employee use of generative AI tools.

August 2025

 BOT to approve changes to Acceptable Use Policy.
