The Harper College Educational Foundation is pleased to announce the recipients of two of Harper College's premiere scholarships – the Motorola Award for Excellence and the Amersham Endowed Scholarship. These scholarships are the highest awards a Harper College student can earn.

Motorola recently awarded a grant to the Harper College Educational Foundation to increase the number of Motorola Award of Excellence awards to two per year. One scholarship is awarded to a traditional aged student (18-23) and one to a non-traditional aged student (24+). The Foundation is grateful for Motorola's continuing support of Harper students.

Motorola Award for Excellence (traditional) - Andrea Rohrbacher

Andrea, who is studying sociology, graduated from Fremd High School in Palatine in just three years so she could spend a year in Mexico as part of a mission group. Andrea's volunteer activities include tutoring at the Mission San Juan Diego in Palatine, taking notes for students enrolled in Harper's ADS program, and translating for nurses who have Spanish-speaking clients. Motorola Distinguished Faculty Award Announced at 2007 Commencement Ceremony

Kris Piepenburg, Assistant Professor of English, is the Motorola Distinguished Faculty Award recipient for 2007. Kris is a Harper College graduate. He served as an adjunct faculty member for five years prior to joining the full-time faculty in 2000.

The ability to connect with students is one of Kris' greatest gifts. He takes extra time for students when English is not their native language and has an ability to make learning fun. He not only cares for learners while they are at Harper but also serves as a guide for former students in their work on Master's theses or other writing activities.

Beyond the classroom, Kris has distinguished himself in service to the College as well as the community. Since 2001 he has served as chairperson for the annual publication of The Harper Anthology. He served as chairperson for the Academic Standards Committee for three years and led the committee through instituting the World Cultures and Diversity graduation requirement. He served as a Senator in the Harper Faculty Senate and shared his musical talent at Faculty Retreats.

His English colleagues, in their letter of support for his nomination said of Kris:

"We love him for how humane he is (especially with his students), for how hard he tries, for how talented he is, for how thorough he is in everything he does and for how completely he has woven himself into the fabric of Harper College."

George and Christine Winandy are long-time Arlington Heights residents who recently established a scholarship for Distinguished Scholars studying math, science, technology or engineering.

The Winandys are of the age when they are required to start taking distributions from their IRA. They decided that they wanted to use the distributions to give back to education and help students.

George attended Wright Junior College in Chicago and received his degree from Marquette University. George and Chris currently support scholarships at Marquette, but also realized how much greater of an impact their donation could have at a community college.

As residents of the Harper College district, they enjoyed reading about Harper and Harper's programs, so they called the Foundation. "I want to give back to education which was good to me," said George. As a retired chemist, George determined that he wanted support students who were studying science, math, technology or engineering.

Their initial gift of \$15,000 will underwrite the cost of the first two years at Harper College as well as the first year at a transfer college or university for one Distinguished Scholar student. Distinguished Scholars are students who have graduated in the top 10% of their graduating high school class. The Winandys plan to continue providing to this scholarship for the next several years.

Interactive Computer Monitoring Equipment for Birthing Simulation Mannequin “Noelle” and Infant

Department: Health Careers and Public Safety

To purchase interactive software and hardware of birthing simulator mannequin which will promote teaching and learning objectives throughout various Health Career and Public Safety programs.

A note from Barb Gawron, Nursing Lab/Simulation Coordinator

Harper College staff member who manages the Birthing Simulation Mannequin “Noelle” and Infant

“On behalf of the faculty and students of the health careers program, I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Foundation for the generous grant funding of the interactive birthing and neonate simulator.

On July 18th Noelle and her neonate arrived with much anticipation at Harper College. The nursing department supply room was transformed into a birthing suite, complete with a birthing bed and infant warmer.

The second semester nursing students are preparing for the first simulation experience with this innovative technology. The scenario: Maria Ramirez is a 23 year old patient in active labor and speaks minimal English. The students will need to assess and interact with this patient and determine the need for an interpreter. They will need to take into consideration her cultural and spiritual beliefs as part of their care. The labor pattern will have some complications which require immediate nursing interventions. Students will be expected to notify appropriate healthcare providers, safely recover the neonate and effectively communicate and collaborate with the team, patient and family.

Community healthcare agencies have expressed an interest in utilizing this simulator to aid in training paramedics and nurses. We also received interest from a midwifery group for possible continuing education in-services.

This interactive neonate represents the future of our health careers program. It will grow and develop improving the critical thinking of healthcare providers caring for mothers and their neonates. Harper College is fortunate to have a visionary Foundation which believes in transforming the future with technological advancement and its incorporation into the curriculum and community. Thank you.”

To provide training and networking opportunities to rising business leaders in the community, including front-line supervisors and mid-level managers.

Developmental Textbook Loan Program for Athletes

Department: Wellness and Human Performance


To create a textbook rental program for student athletes who have difficulty purchasing books during to financial constraints.
