You are being asked to complete this form because the U.S. Department of Selective Service determined that you did not register for Selective Service and were required to do so by the ages of 18 through 25. You may appeal why you did not register in order to receive Federal Financial Aid.

If you appeal for the following reasons, your appeal will be denied and your failure to register will be interpreted as knowing and willful.

- You disagreed with the federal Selective Service Requirement.
- You thought you were automatically registered into the federal Selective Service program and did not have to do anything.
- You had no knowledge of the federal Selective Service requirement.

Please check one of the following conditions that apply as to why you did not register for Selective Service and turn in any supporting signed, documentation to the One Stop:

- I served as a member of one of the U.S. Armed Forces on active duty and received a DD Form 214, "Certification of Release of Discharge from Active Duty" showing military service with the armed forces, other than the reserve forces and released under a condition other than dishonorable. **A signed copy of my DD Form 214 is attached to this form.**
- I was a non-citizen who entered the U.S. after reaching the age of 26 and was therefore unable to register with Selective Service. **A signed copy of my passport with a date of entry stamp, I-94 with date of entry stamp, or a letter from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) indicating the date I entered the United States is attached to this form.**
- I was not yet 18 at the time I completed my FAFSA (an update is not required during the year, even if you turn 18 after completing the application but you must register for Selective Service once you turn 18). **A signed copy of my passport or birth certificate is attached to this form.**

NOTE: The most common reasons to appeal the Selective Service requirement are listed above. There are other reasons for an appeal we can consider. Contact the One Stop to discuss alternatives.
