

## How to Request a Verification of Non-Filing Letter from the Internal Revenue Service

ONLINE (if available) OR PAPER: Form 4506-T

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View and print immediately	Most requests are processed by the IRS within 10 business days
<ul> <li>Go to the IRS website at www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript.</li> </ul>	■ Go to the IRS website at www.irs.gov/form4506t.
Click on "Get Transcript ONLINE."	■ Click on "Form 4506-T (PDF)."
<ul> <li>If you have an existing IRS username, please create a new ID.me account as soon as possible.</li> <li>If you're a new user, please create an account with ID.me (ID.me instructions available here: <a href="https://help.id.me/hc/en-us/articles/360017922513-How-do-I-verify-my-identity-">https://help.id.me/hc/en-us/articles/360017922513-How-do-I-verify-my-identity-</a>)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Complete lines 1 through 4 following the instructions on page 2 of the form.</li> <li>Check the box in item 7 for Verification on Non-filing.</li> <li>Complete item 9. In the year or period requested field, enter the ending date of the tax year you are requesting. (e.g. 12/31/2019 for tax year 2019)</li> <li>Check the signatory authority box above the signature line.</li> <li>The non-filer must sign and date the form and enter their telephone number.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Once logged into your IRS account, follow the prompts to request a "Return Transcript" for the specific Tax Year* for which you would like the document.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Submit the completed Form 4506-T as instructed on page 2 of the form.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>An indicator of the availability of a Verification of Non- filing Letter will appear on the screen.</li> <li>Note: If the Verification of Non-filing Letter for the tax year is not listed, you will need to complete the Form 4506-T.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>If successfully validated, expect to receive he Verification of Non-filing Letter at the address included in your request within 10 business days from the time the request was submitted to the IRS.</li> </ul>
