

## How is my financial aid awarded?

- Once your file is complete, Harper College awards your financial aid.
- Grants are awarded <u>first</u> based on your EFC, eligibility and financial need.
- ► An Award Notification is emailed to you or check *MyHarper* for financial aid awards.

Note: If you are enrolled less than full time, some awards may be reduced or prorated based on your actual enrollment.





## Scholarships – All students should apply

  - Harper Educational Foundation Scholarships
    - o available thru the generosity of Harper College friends and alumni
    - awarded on a competitive basis using criteria such as an applicant's GPA; participation in clubs, organizations, and community service activities; leadership experiences; and personal statement regarding educational and career aspirations
  - Harper Institutional Scholarships
    - o awards and criteria vary
