

Completing the 2016-2017 FAFSA Information You'll Need

In order to complete the 2016-2017 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online during the workshop, you will need to gather the following information. Note: If the student is dependent, then you will also need parents' or legal guardians' information. Provide only the student information if the student is independent. If the student is married, then include any spouse information.

Records of net worth of investments NOTE: Net Worth = Current Value – Debt]	Needed for the student and parent(s) or legal guardian	Needed for the student and spouse (if married)
