ARTICLE I				
Name of the Club

Should the Executive Council find that there is merit, they may fulfill the invocation of Article III, Section IV by granting unique privilege to concerned Member(s) as the Council deems necessary. Unique privilege shall be given to, and only to concerned Member(s). Member(s) may appeal any decision before the Manager of Student Engagement. In any appeals discussion panel, the ratio of the concerned Member(s) and their advocates to each member of their respective club's ruling Executive Council shall not exceed1:1 without the consent of the opposing party. Concerned Member(s), and their rights to confidentiality, shall be observed with the utmost respect.

ARTICLE IV

Officers of the Club

Section1: Officers - The elected officers of this club shall be <u>[President, Vice President, Secretary, and</u> <u>Treasurer]</u>. Listed are general officers, add officers specific to the needs of the club. President and Treasurer are mandatory officer positions for each club.

Section 2: Eligibility:

- **a.** Officers must be Harper students whose main purpose at the College is being a student, carrying at least 1 credit.
- **b.** It is highly recommended that officers must have a grade point average of a 2.0 or above to be elected.
- **c.** It is highly recommended that officers must maintain a grade point average of a 2.0 or above to remain in office.

Section 4: Vacancy – If a vacancy occurs in the office of President, the Vice President shall assume the office for the remainder of the term and vacancies in any other office shall be filled by a special election.
