To apply for Concurrent High School Early College enrollment, you will need to:

- **Complete** the Harper College Application for Admission (*Early College – Concurrent Version*). The application can be completed online at harpercollege.edu or at the Admissions Outreach Office in Rm. C-103.

(**Note:** A one-time \$25 non-refundable application fee will need to be paid online or in C-103 for the Harper College application to be processed. Please do not submit a check with the supplemental form and supporting documents.)

- **Submit** this completed form (including HS verification and all required signatures)
- **Submit** a copy of the high school transcripts
- **Submit** a copy of the ACT score report (if taken)

This information will be reviewed by a counselor in the Center for New Students and Orientation in order to determine your eligibility to enroll. Additional information and/or a meeting with a counselor in the Center for New Students may be necessary before a final admission determination can be made.

***This entire process may take approx. two weeks to complete.
Please plan accordingly.***
