

## St. Benedict Award

<b>Amount</b>	Up to \$11,000 per year according to the following scale:
	GPA                      Award Per Year
	3.75-4.00              \$11,000
	3.51-3.74              \$9,400
	3.26-3.50              \$7,800
	3.00-3.25              \$6,300
	2.75-2.99              \$3,200
<b>Eligibility</b>	Cumulative college 2.75/4.0 GPA for transfer students; full-time enrollment
<b>Renewability</b>	Cumulative 3.0/4.0 GPA; full-time enrollment

## Catholic High School Recognition Award

<b>Amount</b>	\$2,000 per year
<b>Eligibility</b>	Graduate from a Catholic high school
<b>Renewability</b>	Full-time enrollment

## Alumni Recognition Award

<b>Amount</b>	Up to \$1,000 per year, per parent
<b>Eligibility</b>	Son or daughter of a Benedictine University alumnus. Parent(s) must have graduated from a Benedictine University undergraduate, graduate or doctorate degree program.
<b>Renewability</b>	Full-time enrollment

## Sibling Recognition Award

<b>Amount</b>	Up to \$1,500 per year maximum regardless of number of currently or previously enrolled siblings. This award is not applicable for currently enrolled sibling(s).
<b>Eligibility</b>	Incoming student with a currently enrolled sibling(s) or if sibling(s) is a Benedictine University alumnus
<b>Renewability</b>	Full-time enrollment

## Music Scholarship

<b>Amount</b>	Up to \$4,000 per year
<b>Eligibility</b>	Successful completion of a music audition with the Music department; declared major or minor in music
<b>Renewability</b>	Maintain a 3.0 GPA; enroll in at least one music course per semester with music department advisor approval; full-time enrollment

## Please Note

- Full-time enrollment is defined as 12 or more semester hours per term.
- Final transcripts must be received no later than 30 days after the first day of the term in which you are enrolled.
- Student financial aid programs, terms and conditions are subject to change without notice or obligation.
- The Benedictine Scholars Program Award, St. Benedict Award and Phi Theta Kappa Award are mutually exclusive and may not be combined.
- Incoming sophomores: Limited to a maximum of three years or six terms of institutional awards.
- Incoming juniors: Limited to a maximum of two years or four terms of institutional awards.

## Phi Theta Kappa Award

<b>Amount</b>	Up to \$12,000 per year according to the following scale:

<b>Eligibility</b>	Member of Phi Theta Kappa; Cumulative 3.0/4.0 GPA; Full-time enrollment
<b>Renewability</b>	Cumulative 3.25/4.0 GPA; full-time enrollment

## Out-of-State Award

<b>Amount</b>	Up to \$5,000 per year
<b>Eligibility</b>	Given to students who are residents of a state other than Illinois and will reside on campus while attending the University
<b>Renewability</b>	Full-time enrollment

## Benedictine Scholars Program Award

<b>Amount</b>	\$13,100 per year
<b>Eligibility</b>	Awarded by the Scholars Committee to a limited number of incoming students; not applicable to students in the pre-pharmacy program. Transfer students must have a maximum of 60 semester credit hours and a 3.2/4.0 cumulative GPA. Students must have completed a minimum of four years of foreign language at the high school level. Students who have a previous associate degree are not eligible. This award can not be combined with any other institutional tuition awards.
<b>Renewability</b>	Continued participation in the Scholars Program; cumulative 3.2/4.0 GPA; full-time enrollment

## Opportunity Award

<b>Amount</b>	\$3,000 per year
<b>Eligibility</b>	Graduate from a high school with more than one-third of the student population considered to be from "low-income" families (determined by the "Teacher Cancellation Low Income Directory" published by the United States Department of Education)
<b>Renewability</b>	Full-time enrollment

- Incoming seniors: Limited to a maximum of one year or two terms of institutional awards.
- In most cases, there is a limit to institutional awards.
- Students seeking a second degree or second major do not qualify for these scholarships.
- Students from the Benedictine University at Springfield branch campus are not eligible for these scholarships as they qualify for special tuition rates.
- Students who have a previous bachelor's, master's or doctoral degree are not eligible for these scholarships.
