<sup>6</sup> Waiver must be approved to count for EDF 2555 for major. Course will not count towards General Education.

**Note 1 – A grade of "C" or better is required in all courses**

**Note 2- Foreign Language is a graduation Requirement. Two full years of high school foreign language with a "C" average or completion of the second semester of a college foreign language will satisfy this requirement.**
