

## **PROPOSED DEPAUL UNIVERSITY MS IN MANAGEMENT AT HARPER UNIVERSITY CENTER**

The Master of Science in Management (MSM) from DePaul University's Kellstadt Graduate School of Business prepares professionals to gain a thorough understanding of business management theory and techniques. This program, which begins in January 2021, will prepare you to successfully lead, manage and implement change in a wide range of organizations.

The DePaul MSM will be delivered on-site at Harper University Center in a cohort format. You will take courses with the same group of individuals in a sequenced set of 14 courses totaling 52 credit hours (see course schedule on the other side for details).

- Earn your advanced degree from DePaul in just over a year and a half
- Never worry about getting into classes. Your Kellstadt advisor will enroll you each quarter and support you throughout the program
- Once enrolled, you will be able to access the Kellstadt Career Management Center and take advantage of other DePaul University resources
- Upon graduation, join a distinguished alumni network with over 118,000 alumni in the Chicago metro area

### **COST**

DePaul provides a 25% tuition discount for students participating in the Harper MSM cohort program, which requires a minimum of at least 20 students.

Students with an undergraduate business degree may be eligible for course waivers, further lowering their tuition cost. Students should inquire with their human resources department about tuition reimbursement benefits.

The Harper-DePaul discount cannot be combined with any other DePaul scholarship or discount or DePaul financial aid award. Loans, federal and state grants, and non-DePaul scholarships are available, as well as flexible payment option plans, to those who qualify. Your employer tuition reimbursement benefit enables you to apply for DePaul's deferred payment plan. A small tuition increase may occur for all MSM students, Harper cohort students included, in upcoming academic years.

- Letters of recommendation are not required
- A personal essay is not required
- Application fee will be waived
